

# Honors Current & Transfer Curriculum

## What is the Honors Current & Transfer Curriculum?

- Required curriculum track for all currently enrolled ECU students or students transferring to ECU who begin in ECU Honors after their first semester
- Allows you to use any credits you've already accumulated toward general education requirements
- Requires completion of 18 credit hours of Honors coursework that can be used to complete general education credits you still need

## What courses make up the 18 credit hours of the Honors Current & Transfer Curriculum?

- ECU Honors has a course number that will fulfill each element of ECU's general education program. You'll pick three courses from the following:
  - HON 304W (mathematics)
  - HON 307W (arts)
  - HON 308W (humanities)
  - HON 310W (history)
  - HON 312W (social & behavioral science)
  - HON 317 (natural science)
  - HON 320W (diversity)
- You don't have to take every single one of these courses. You pick the ones that you need with assistance from your Honors advisor.
  - Example: Already taken a history credit? You probably won't take an HON 310W for a history credit.
  - Brought in AP Calculus? You probably won't take an HON 304W for a math credit.
- Then, you'll complete HON 420: Honors Thesis (6 credit hours), typically during your junior/senior years.

## What else do I need to know?

- You will have an Honors advisor and an advisor in your major who will help you build a schedule and create a plan for your time at ECU.
- You do not have to take an Honors course every semester to remain in ECU Honors.
